What’s on the TEST:

1. LISTENING

- Know your numbers! (1-100) You have to be able to match clothing items with their prices.
- Know all of your clothing vocabulary including colors and descriptions of how they fit. See your 4XEaches AND p. 155 of your text.

2. GRAMMAR AND VOCAB

- Know your colors.
- Know the genders of these clothing items *because* you will have to be able to use the correct form of *ein* in front of them. (*ein, eine, einen*, or - [if it’s plural!])

- Know the genders of these clothing items *because* you will have to be able to use the correct *definite article* in front of them. (*der, die, das, den*)

- Know the genders of these clothing items *because* you will have to replace them with their pronouns—keeping in mind that the *masculine* form of “it” *might* have to be in the *ACCUSATIVE—direct object* case! (*er, sie, es, ihn*)

Rock | T-Shirt | Jacke | Schuhe | Pullover

- Know the meanings of *nehmen* and *aus*sehen* and be able to conjugate them properly. You will see a sentence missing the verbs, and you will have to choose the correct verb and the correct conjugation of that verb.
