

WHAT'S LEFT?

Following the instructions, cross off words in the diagram. When you are finished, the remaining words will form a message reading left to right, line by line. Some words may be eliminated by more than one of the instructions. Words that have been crossed off may be used to eliminate other words.

1. Cross off all words in columns A and C that contain double consonants.
2. Cross off all words that are surnames of famous painters.
3. Cross off all words in columns B and D that contain double vowels (A, E, I, O, or U).
4. Cross off all 8-letter words that can be split into two 4-letter words.
5. Cross off all words that contain an abbreviation for the name of a month.
6. Cross off all words that end in two vowels.
7. Cross off all 5-letter words that consist of two smaller words.
8. Cross off all words that contain three of any one consonant.
9. Cross off all words that form a new word or phrase when added before or after STOP.
10. Cross off all 4-letter words whose letters are in alphabetical order.
