## **Act 1 Questions**

- 1. a sonnet poem
- 2. to tell what will happen in the play
- 3. a poem that has to be written in a specific format
- 4.14
- 5. 4
- 6. abab cdcd efef gg
- 7. lines poetry with 10 syllables each, but don't rhyme each other
- 8.10
- 9. 2 syllables in a line of poetry that sound like a heartbeat—tah DUM weak then STRONG syllables
- 10. servants of the CAPULET family (Juliet's family)
- 11. start a big fight with the MONTAGUE servants in the middle of the city
- 12. Verona, Italy
- 13. the Prince: Prince Escalus
- 14. death
- 15. Romeo's nice cousin
- 16. some girl who Romeo is love-sick about
- 17. to show him that other girls are prettier than Rosaline
- 18. to prove to Benvolio that no girl is prettier than Rosaline

#### **Act 2 Questions**

- 26. 1 character talks for a long time while other characters listen
- 27. 1 character talks for a long time to himself all alone on stage
- 28. a modern translation of the Shakespeare lines—without losing any of the specific images
- 29. "Why did you have to belong to the MONTAGUE family?"
- 30. Romeo and Juliet decide to get married
- 31. ONLY when there is a period or a comma. NOT at the end of a line—just keep reading!
- 32. a religious monk and close friend to Romeo
- 33. peace-maker, calming influence, intelligent about plants
- 34. the Nurse
- 35. Juliet's nanny
- 36. Romeo's friend and the Prince's cousin
- 37. really obnoxious and arrogant
- 38. he hopes it will end the family feud between the Capulets and the Montagues
- 39. a soliloquy
- 40. Tybalt
- 41. it challenged Romeo to a sword fight because Romeo crashed the Capulets' party
- 42. GO SLOWLY! Stop rushing into things!

- 43. He is feeling grief and a fear of the future
- 44. banishment, exile, kicked out of the city
- 45. when Romeo killed Tybalt, it was giving the same punishment to Tybalt that the law would have
- 46. full of self-pity
- 47. re-write it in modern language without losing any of the images in it
- 48. he promises that Juliet will agree to marry Paris
- 49. he tells Juliet to either marry Paris or else go live on the street
